

Town of Franklin Hazardous Waste Collection Day



SATURDAY, OCTOBER 3, 2009

Location: Franklin Town Hall (355 E. Central St.)

Pre-registration required! Tickets are \$10/vehicle

The Franklin Department of Public Works is sponsoring a Household Hazardous Waste Collection Day on Saturday, October 3rd (rain or shine) at the Town Hall located at 355 East Central St. The collection day is for Franklin residents only. Tickets are \$10 per vehicle and are required prior to the event. Pre-registration begins September 1st at the DPW office (257 Fisher St.). Tickets are limited. First come, first serve.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Participation is limited to residents of Franklin. Positive proof of residence such as a driver's license, tax bill, or other identification must be provided when pre-registering.

This is a non-commercial collection and is intended for household wastes only!

WHERE & WHEN?

Waste collection will take place at Town Hall located at 355 E. Central Street from the hours of 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM on Saturday, October 3, 2009. Those wishing to participate must purchase a ticket for \$10/vehicle and schedule an appointment at the DPW office located at 257 Fisher St. Those without tickets will NOT be admitted.

WHAT CAN I BRING?

HOW WILL IT WORK?

You will drive into the parking lot of Town Hall at the time of your appointment. Once there, someone will check your identification and ticket. While you wait in your vehicle, a specially trained worker will remove the items from your car and dispose of them properly. The entire process should not take more than a few minutes.

TRANSPORTATION TIPS:

Leave materials in original containers

Tighten caps and lids

Pack your vehicle and drive directly to the site

Pack containers in sturdy, upright boxes and pad with newspaper if necessary.

NEVER MIX CHEMICALS

NEVER SMOKE or eat while handling or transporting hazardous materials.
