Call **800-248-8898 X28** by Tuesday and your metal item will be picked up on Thursday!

FREE

Bicycles, grills, toaster ovens, microwaves, metal furniture, metal toys, heaters and other metal items less than 40 pounds.

\$25 with Sticker (Purchase at DPW)

Appliances, hot water heaters, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, copiers, stoves and any other larger metal items.

A major cost saving initiative is under way and your help is needed. It costs 1/2 as much money to process recycling products than it does to dispose of trash. Items that are not recycled are costing you thousands of dollars a day.

Recycling Made Easy...

Paper and Cardboard

All catalogs, mail, boxes, cardboard, newspapers, soft cover books, magazines...

Pizza boxes OK!

If you can rip it, recycle it.

All cardboard must be cut smaller than 3 X 3 feet and flat or it won't fit in the truck!

- Please take the newspapers out of plastic bags
- Shredded paper? Put it in paper bags and staple
- Trash put in cardboard boxes will not be picked up, flatten boxes and put with recycling bins

Glass, Metal & Plastic Containers

Aluminum, empty aerosol cans, glass (any color), metal cans, stiff plastic - #1-7

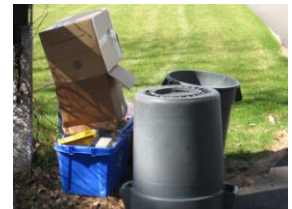
Please don't put items in plastic bags, just loose in the recycling bin.

USER PERMIT FEE: \$10

Permits valid July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010



Disposal Fees:

Clean asphalt, bricks & concrete - \$10 per load

TV, computer monitors - \$15 each

Tires - \$5 each, can be on rims

Auto batteries - \$3 each

Propane tanks - \$3 each for 20 pound, leave valves on, partial fill accepted

Freon appliances - \$15 each



What you should take (No charge items)

Paper + Cardboard – All you can haul, no need to cut, just flatten!

Glass Jars, Bottles + Plastic containers – Please rinse, labels and lids ok to leave

Scrap metal + Appliances – Hot water heaters, lawn mowers

Yard debris – leaves, grass, brush + branches (please smaller than 6" diameter) – no stumps!

Books, Audio CD and DVD – Also computer software.

Engine oil – auto, lawnmower, etc

Automotive coolant – Empty your clean coolant here

Fluorescent bulbs – all sizes (including new small ones), don't tape!

Mercury products – Thermometers, thermostats, medical devices

Clothes – Donations go to help support the Franklin Library
